

He said that AIDS is likely to spread by establishing unprotected set using infected needles, using infected blood, using infected saving blades at barber shops, etc. He said that the symptom of AIDS include fever, sore throat, lumps appearing anywhere in the body, Immunity Power Week is a common symptom of AIDS and he discussed about AIDS in deta Dr. Manoj Gupta, TV and HIV Coordinator said that man people go out to cities for labour, etc. and that too due staying out of the house, they get vulnerable to this disease due to having unsafe relations, people go out to eat livelihood and bring the disease home, so care should taken, he said that more than one sexual partner should not be had. This is the biggest cause for AIDS, after which the volunteers cooked and ate food, everyone looked ve excited in it.
